

Solar Panel Maintenance and Replacement Costs: What Builders and Buyers Should Know

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As rooftop solar becomes a standard feature in new-build homes across the UK, understanding the long-term cost of solar panels is essential – for both housebuilders and homeowners.

Solar Panel Maintenance Costs in the UK

Regular servicing and upkeep ensures optimal performance and longevity of home solar systems. For homeowners who own their system outright, it's important to factor in the following routine costs:

- **Annual Servicing:** Professional inspections and servicing helps to maintain your system’s overall health and efficiency, costs between £100 and £300 per year.
- **Solar Panel Cleaning:** Solar panels work best when they’re clean because dirt, pollen and other debris can block sunlight, reducing your system’s performance over time. It’s best to have your solar panels professionally cleaned at least once every year, with costs ranging from £100 to £250, depending on system size and accessibility.
- **Insurance:** If you own your solar system, you’ll need to insure it. Ensure your policy provides coverage for the solar panels as well as the inverter and battery system. Adding a solar system to home insurance policies can cost an additional £60 to £100 annually.

Replacement Costs

Typically, solar panels have a lifespan of 25 to 30 years and, barring physical damage or manufacturing defects, are unlikely to need replacement during that time. But that’s not the full story:

- **Solar inverters**, the component that converts solar energy into usable electricity, usually need replacing every 10–15 years. Replacement costs in the UK range from £730 to £1,460, depending on the type and capacity
- **Battery storage** has become an important feature of future-ready new homes. Like inverters, they typically have a lifespan of 10–15 years depending on usage and technology. Costs to replace the battery vary based on capacity and brand, with prices averaging around £5,000 and increasing to as much as £10,000.

Lifetime Repair Costs:

When combining maintenance and component replacement, the total lifetime cost of owning solar panels in the UK can reach:

£12,230 – £22,710 over a typical 25-year system lifespan.

These components can see households running into significant out-of-pocket costs if they're unprepared for them.

Solar Ownership vs Solar Leasing: Cost Comparison

Understanding the cost-benefit of solar lease vs ownership in the UK is important for homeowners deciding how to access solar energy.

Outright purchase of a solar system can offer the best long-term savings if you expect to stay in your home for 25 years or more – long enough to recoup the upfront investment through energy bill savings. However, it's important to weigh this against both the high initial cost of the hardware and the ongoing maintenance and repair needs, and the fact that these savings typically depend on not moving home before the payback period ends.
